Safe*Ride*

Texas Woman's University encourages all employees and their family members to act responsibly by not driving under the influence of alcohol. To ensure your safety, Alliance Work Partners (AWP) offers SafeRide. SafeRide is intended for those occasions when calling a cab is the right thing to do. The program is provided to you at NO COST and is 100% CONFIDENTIAL.

If you find yourself in a situation where you or someone you are riding with is incapacitated, call your local cab company or rideshare service for a safe ride home.

Key Points to Remember:

- Up to 50 miles one way
- AWP reimburses the cab / rideshare fare (no tips, fees or surcharges), up to \$50.00
- Up to 3 times in a 3 year period
- Second claim within a 12 month period requires telephonic assessment
- Third claim within a 36 month period requires face to face assessment

When to take a Safe Ride:

- Drunk / "one too many" alcoholic beverages
- Drowsiness due to medication
- Emotional distress (i.e., receives bad news on the job, learns of a death in the family, finalizing a divorce, etc.)

The coverage updates for the HealthSelectSM Prescription Drug Program (PDP) took effect Sept. 1

- The PDP now covers the following diabetic strips and supplies:
 - Contour[®] and OneTouch[®] glucometers are available under the Free Glucose Meter Program. These items must be ordered <u>by presenting a voucher</u> at the in-network pharmacy. Call OptumRx customer service toll-free at (855) 828-9834; TTY: 711 for more information about ordering the glucometers.
 - Contour and OneTouch test strips, lancets and lancing devices have a \$0 copay at in-network pharmacies for HealthSelect of Texas[®] participants. Consumer Directed HealthSelectSM participants must meet their deductible before the \$0 copay takes effect.
- Other diabetic supplies covered under the HealthSelect PDP preferred drug list are included in the tier 2 or tier 3 copays.
 - Consumer Directed HealthSelect now covers insulin before the participant meets the annual deductible. To get coverage before meeting the deductible, the participant must fill the prescription at an in-network pharmacy. The participant will be responsible for the copay/coinsurance.

Upcoming Pay Dates: January 3, 2023 February 1, 2023

Reminder: The December payroll pay date will be **Tuesday**, **January 3**, **2023**.

Distribution of 2022 W-2s The Payroll Department is currently preparing for the 2022 W-2 Wage and Tax Statements. The Form W-2 is an annual form that reports your Federal and State wages and other tax information required by Federal and State agencies. It is also used by the Social Security Administration as a verification document to ensure individuals are properly credited for future Social Security and Medicare benefits.

Sign up to receive your W-2 electronically! Have you signed up to receive your W-2 electronically? If you have already consented to receive your W-2 electronically, no action is required. To sign up for electronic W-2 for 2022, log-in to After you have received a new social security card, please notify the Human Resources Department. Using a new name without updating the Social Security Administration's records may prevent the posting of your Social Security and Medicare earnings. Instructions for obtaining a replacement Social Security card or changing information on your Social Security number record are located on Form SS-5 Application for a Social Security Card.

Address Changes Please verify that your address as listed on your payslip is accurate. If you have recently moved or need to make a change, update your address via TWU Employee Self-Service through Oracle. TWU Employee Self-Service may be accessed at any TWU oncampus computer or through VPN by logging into Oracle. Choose Personal Information and update your address accordingly. If you will not be on campus, you may download the <u>Address Change Form.</u> located under the Payroll heading.

Form W-4, Employee's Withholding Certificate Now is the time to check your Federal tax withholding. Did you marry or divorce, gain or lose a dependent, or had major changes in your family income? If you answered "yes", you may need to file a new Form W-4. You may update
